Incident: Motor Vehicle Collision

On Wednesday, December 5, 2007 the Egg Harbor Township Police Department responded to a motor vehicle collision which occurred at approximately 11:34 pm on Zion Rd between Schoolhouse Rd and English Creek Ave in the Scullville section of the township.

A 2001 Dodge Durango operated by Nicholas D DiDomenico wt/m 30 yoa of Egg Harbor Twp was proceeding west on Zion Rd when his vehicle crossed over the opposing lane of travel and exited the road surface onto the east bound shoulder.

The vehicle then collided with a utility pole and a large tree before returning to the travel portion of the road surface and achieving rest.

Nicholas D DiDomenico sustained multiple injuries and was transported to AtlantiCare Regional Medical Center, City Campus Trauma Unit by EHT EMS and Medics. Status: Critical

DiDomenico was unrestrained in the vehicle.

The Scullville Volunteer Fire Dept. also responded and assisted with auxiliary lighting.

Traffic was detoured for approximately 2 hrs while the collision was being investigated and cleared. The collision is being investigated by the Egg Harbor Twp. Police Dept. Traffic Safety Unit.
