# NEWS RELEASE

Incident: Recovered stolen vehicle

On Sunday, October 21, 2007 at approximately 5:50 pm Officers Chris Ives & Michelle Fromal were on patrol in the area of the Nafec Circle when they utilized their mobile data terminal inside their patrol car & ran a license plate on a vehicle that passed by them.

When the results of the inquiry came back, they learned that this vehicle was reported stolen during an armed car jacking incident out of Camden City, NJ on Saturday, October 20, 2007.

Ives & Fromal continued to follow this vehicle until back up units arrived at which time a "High Risk" motor vehicle stop was made at the WaWa located at Tilton Road & the White Horse Pike in Galloway Twsp., NJ. Galloway Twsp. PD assisted with the stop.

Found during the stop was a loaded handgun, crack cocaine, heroin and drug paraphernalia.

Arrested & charged in this incident were the following:

1. Driver of the car; James Hinson, 30 years old of Camden City, NJ  
Charges: Receiving stolen property, Poss. Of a handgun, Poss. Of CDS, Distribution of Drug paraphernalia, Obstruction of Justice & contempt of court.
2. Obiora Orange, 31 years old of Camden City, NJ  
Charges: Receiving stolen property, Poss. Of a handgun, Poss of CDS, Distribution of Drug paraphernalia, Obstruction of Justice & contempt of court.
3. Christopher Payne, 30 years old of Egg Harbor Twsp., NJ  
Charges: Loitering to buy CDS & Poss. Of drug paraphernalia.

Payne was released on a summons while Hinton & Orange were lodged in the Atlantic County Justice Facility on \$75,000.00 cash bail set by Hon. H. R. Switzer, JMC.

Assisting Ives & Fromal were Ofc. Brian Dickson & Det. Fred Spano of the EHTPD. A follow up investigation is underway by the Camden City PD Robbery/Auto Theft Unit with assistance of the EHTPD.
