UPDATE

Incident: Aggravated Assault

On Tuesday, February 23, 2010, at approximately 10:00 am, Brittany Campbell turned herself in at the Egg Harbor Township Police Department on the Aggravated Assault warrant issued from the incident described below. Municipal Court Judge H. R. Switzer set bail for the charges at \$10,000/10%. Campbell was able to post bail and was released pending court.

On Saturday, February 20, 2010, at approximately 5:08 pm, the Egg Harbor Township Police Department responded to the Super Wawa (Black Horse Pike and Uibel Ave.), in the Cardiff section of the Township, for the report of an aggravated assault with a vehicle. Officer John DeFazio responded and made contact with the victims, Lilah Ormond (28 years of age from Voorhees, NJ) and Aubry Green (28 years of age from Mickelton, NJ). Green stated his ex-girlfriend, Brittany Campbell (22 years of age from Galloway Township) pulled her vehicle in front of Ormond's vehicle while they were at the gas pumps at the Wawa. After yelling at Ormond, Campbell deliberately struck the front of Ormond's vehicle with her vehicle. Ormond got out to check the damage and was then struck by Campbell's vehicle, rolled over the hood of Campbell's vehicle and was then run over by the vehicle. Campbell left the scene west on Tilton Road.

Ormond was treated at the scene by the Egg Harbor Township Ambulance Squad and Atlanticare Paramedics for multiple injuries. She was transported to the Atlanticare Trauma Center in Atlantic City.

Campbell has been charged with 2 counts of aggravated assault and criminal mischief. A warrant has been issued for her arrest but has not been located as yet. This incident is being investigated by Det. Heath Per, Fred Spano and

Mark Wagner of the Egg Harbor Township Police Department Detective Bureau.
